

Our Actions

- 3 Protests in Sydney
- Social Media Campaign
- Email campaign targeting AOC heads and the Sports Minister
- 2 articles in UK featured our protests.

Positive Change: IOC postponed the decision to vote on allowing russian and bellorussian athletes to participate in the Olympics. The decision is expected to take place at the end of March. The Australian Sports Minister took a strong stance that fully aligns with what we want (banning all russian and belorussian athletes).

Positive Change: Germany stopped blocking the oil embargo. Germany softened their position on gas embargo (they are no longer publicly against it). Germany started to supply heavy weapons to Ukraine. Germany agreed to send Leopard tanks.

Our Actions

- Coordinating internationally

Positive Change: Amnesty Australia made an apology and a statement on their website confirming the harmful nature of their reports on Ukraine. Amnesty international stopped discrediting Ukraine. Amnesty International listened to our demands and released a strong statement condemning the intended sham trials of Ukrainian POWs in Mariupol. As the result of international pressure trials did not eventuate.



Positive Change: Hungary caved to pressure and stopped blocking the oil embargo. Hungary decided not to block EU membership prospects for Ukraine.

Ukrainian community activists are outraged after the Russian Red Cross was caught welcoming donations of cash, uniforms and drones towards Putin's military machine.

Our Actions

- Countless protests

- 3 Meetings with Australian Red Cross and ICRC representatives
- An investigation into Red Cross russia
- Multiple newspaper articles and a TV interview
- Multiple e-mail exchanges with heads of the Australian Red Cross and ICRC

Positive Change: Green corridors and prisoner exchanges started to work after the initial contact at the start of the war. Ukraine's delegation used the findings from our investigation to stop Red Cross russia's attempts to discredit Ukraine and block weapon supplies.

Economic War



What is Economic War?

- Every war is not only a war of soldiers and weapons, but also a war of economies
- The sooner russian economy collapses, the sooner russia will stop attacking Ukraine
- Our goal is to make sure that all western businesses exit russia, which will lead to loss of jobs, taxes, products and services.

Nestle



Our Actions

- 3 Protests in Sydney
- 1 meeting with CEO of Nestle Oceania
- Social Media Campaign

Positive Change: Nestle made a stronger statement immediately after our protest and promised not to make profits in russia. Nestle stopped selling Nesquick and KitKat in russia after our protests. Nestle has committed to making 0 profits in russia and to donating all their russian profits to Ukraine (so that they pay 0 taxes in russia).

Positive Change: Pepsi made a stronger statement, Pepsi cancelled their multi-million dollar potato deal with russia.





Positive Change: Canva fully exited the russian market causing huge outrage in russia. They canceled almost 1.5 million accounts in russia.

Positive Change: Atlassian made a commitment to exit russia and belarus. The process of fully withdrawing from russia is ongoing. Atlassian is in the process of donating over \$6 Million to Ukrainian charities.


